PREFACE

This second edition is a cumulation of the 1st edition, 1998 with some changes and deletions. The latter included removing the printed music and map materials for reasons that access to them through the National Library's OPAC is straight forward. Additions included the PROMPT theatre programs and an increase of approx. 200 entries over the previous ed. The major change is the re-arrangement which mixes the various material formats of printed materials, pictorial, manuscripts, sound recordings into one alphabetical sequence arranged primarily by author or title. The format has not been included and entries are generally a little shorter than previously as the Bibliography is meant to be a guide to the Library's holdings. It is assumed the user will access the OPAC for further details.

The selected material concerns the activities, intellectual output of Poles in Australia whether permanent residents or not from the period of white settlement in Australia, from 1788 to the present. It also includes them as a subject, regardless of whether written by this ethnic group or not. Generally it excludes belle-lettres although some specimens have been included. The compiler knows the National Library does hold their writings because under the National Library Act and the Copyright Act, the Library has a statutory requirement to collect this material.

This list was compiled on behalf of the Polish Historical Institute in Australia whose own collection in the National Library it is meant to complement.

Other members of the Institute who gave ideas toward its expanded compilation include: Joanna Biega, Mark Biega, Barbara Rozmus, Anna Skurowski and Teresa Wojkowska.

However it is to Monica and John Andrew that I owe deep gratitude for giving their time and advice in the electronic compilation of this document.
